MINUTES FOR MONDAY, FEBRUARY 5, 2024**

Travis Dill discussed the TAP Grant with the Commissioners regarding Latimer County.

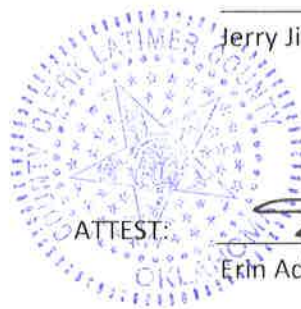
