

LATIMER COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
MEETING MINUTES FOR FEBRUARY 9, 2026

The Latimer County Commissioners met in a regular meeting on Friday, February 9, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. at the Latimer County Courthouse located at 109 N. Central, Wilburton, OK. Members present were Jeremy Bullard, Jaden Petty, and Rodger Kimble. Erin Adams, Latimer County Clerk took the minutes.

Jaden Petty, Chairman, called the meeting to order.

Under old business:

Under new business:

The Commissioners discussed the weekly Emergency Managers report. Montgomery stated that 4 sirens were not working and needed maintenance. Montgomery also stated that a technician had been called and he was waiting on a call back. The Commissioners stated the importance and severity of the repairs due to the tornado season approaching.

Commissioner Kimble discussed the updated information received from the Department of Labor regarding the asbestos findings within the Courthouse. Kimble stated that a representative from the Department of Labor is aware of the test results and the work that was done inside the Courthouse and stated that as long as the materials are in good condition now it could remain operational, and that if the Commissioners chose to have an air quality test done within the Courthouse building, that it would be a good faith measure. Kimble further stated that ACCO does not have any type of mobile testing for employees. The Courthouse does have high quality air purifiers in every office and all hallways, that have been in place for several years and are checked routinely.




