

LATIMER COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

MEETING MINUTES FOR FEBRUARY 23, 2026

The Latimer County Commissioners met in a regular meeting on Friday, February 23, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. at the Latimer County Courthouse located at 109 N. Central, Wilburton, OK. Erin Adams, Latimer County Clerk took the minutes.

Jaden Petty, Chairman, called the meeting to order.

The Board reviewed the results from the air quality test. The testing was done by Marshall Environmental Management, Inc. Results stated that all samples taken with the Courthouse building came back under detectable levels.

The Commissioners discussed with the Emergency Director, Nathan Montgomery regarding the weekly report. Montgomery stated that there are 5 out of 19 sirens that are not working within the county. He also discussed with the Commissioners regarding the contact that has been made to the technician for repairs.


The Board discussed the 2026-2027 ACCO SIG policies/handbooks. No action was taken. No new business was discussed.
