The Latimer County Commissioners met in a regular meeting on Monday, March 16, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. at the Latimer County Courthouse located at 109 N Central, Wilburton, OK. Leigh Ivanoff, 1st Deputy, Latimer County Clerks office took the minutes.

Jaden Petty, Chairman, called the meeting to order.




