

LATIMER COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
MEETING MINUTES FOR MAY 11, 2026

The Latimer County Commissioners met in a regular meeting on Monday, May 11, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. at the Latimer County Courthouse located at 109 N Central, Wilburton, OK. Members present were Jeremy Bullard, Jaden Petty, and Rodger Kimble. Guests were: Leland Walker, Luke Underwood, Karen Ford, Jana Scott, Nathan Montgomery, Bryan Lewis, Chassidy Eubanks, Ryan Robinson, Mark Showell and Wade Hoyt Thomson. Erin Adams, Latimer County Clerk, took the minutes.

Jaden Petty, Chairman, called the meeting to order.

Rodger Kimble made a motion to approve to sign meeting minutes from 05/04/2026. Jeremy Bullard seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Bullard-aye; Petty-aye; Kimble-aye. The motion carried.

Jeremy Bullard made a motion to approve and sign the miscellaneous appropriations. Rodger Kimble seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Petty-aye; Kimble-aye; Bullard-aye. The motion carried.

Jeremy Bullard made a motion to approve and sign payroll and M&O claims. Rodger Kimble seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Petty-aye; Kimble-aye; Bullard-aye. The motion carried.

Rodger Kimble made a motion to approve the monthly reports for Court Clerk, County Health, County Clerk and the Treasurer for April 2026. Jeremy Bullard seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Bullard-aye; Petty-aye; Kimble-aye. The motion carried.

The Board reviewed the Collection Summary Report from the Treasurer thru: 04/30/2026.

Rodger Kimble made a motion to approve the Purchase Card Payment Approval Form for the Sheriff's Department; totaling \$653.14. Jeremy Bullard seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Bullard-aye; Petty-aye; Kimble-aye. The motion carried.

Rodger Kimble made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2026-30 regarding the donation from CCPF totaling \$13,700.00. Jeremy Bullard seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Bullard-aye; Petty-aye; Kimble-aye. The motion carried.

Jeremy Bullard made a motion to approve the Programming Resolution Project No. 2026-31; blading gravel & asphalt for the purpose of releveling a portion of 21 Mine Road/EW 144 NS 432.5-NS432; within District #1. Estimated cost of project is \$15,000.00. Rodger Kimble seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Petty-aye; Kimble-aye; Bullard-aye. The motion carried.

Jeremy Bullard made a motion on clearing the fence row and reworking ditch on Dunagan Lane; NS 425 starting EW 145.5 ending 144.6; within District #1. Rodger Kimble seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Petty-aye; Kimble-aye; Bullard-aye. The motion carried.

Rodger Kimble made a motion to approve the letter requesting assistance from District #3 regarding one load of UPM to be delivered to the cement pad at the park. Jeremy Bullard seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Bullard-aye; Petty-aye; Kimble-aye. The motion carried.

The Board discussed the donation of one of the trucks under the Emergency Management Department inventory to be transferred to the Sheriff's Department's inventory. No action was taken.

There was no Emergency Management's weekly report to review.

Jeremy Bullard made a motion to approve for District #2 to go out for bids on the following: 8' steel pipe/railroad tank car. Rodger Kimble seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Petty-aye; Kimble-aye; Bullard-aye. The motion carried.

The Board discussed updating the vending machines within the Courthouse; information provided by Oklahoma Rehabilitation Services. No action was taken.

Rodger Kimble made a motion in open meeting to adjourn Executive Session and reconvene at 9:38 a.m. Jeremy Bullard seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Bullard-aye; Petty-aye; Kimble-aye. The motion carried.

Under old business:

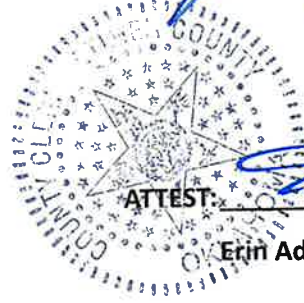
The Board discussed to go for bids on AED Machines; project funded through the Opioid Abatement Funds. No action was taken.
