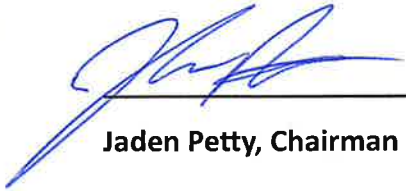

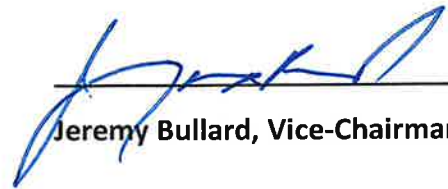
Under old business:
