MEETING MINUTES FOR JULY 20, 2026

The Latimer County Commissioners met in a regular meeting on Monday, July 20, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. at the Latimer County Courthouse/Courtroom, located at 109 N Central, Wilburton, OK. Jaden Petty, Chairman, called the meeting to order.

Jeremy Bullard made a motion to approve the minutes from 07/13/2026. Jaden Petty seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Bullard-aye; Petty-aye; Kimble-abstain. The motion carried.

Jeremy Bullard made a motion to approve and sign the miscellaneous appropriations. Rodger Kimble seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Petty-aye; Kimble-aye; Bullard-aye. The motion carried.

Jeremy Bullard made a motion to approve the Monthly Reports for June 2026 for the Treasurer, County Clerk and County Health. Rodger Kimble seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Petty-aye; Kimble-aye; Bullard-aye. The motion carried.

Rodger Kimble made a motion to approve the mileage reimbursement rate memo from SA&I; effective July 1, 2026. Jeremy Bullard seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Petty-aye; Kimble-aye; Bullard-aye. The motion carried.

Rodger Kimble made a motion for the Latimer County Conservation District to go out for bid on a 25' flatbed trailer with a 5' dovetail as needed for 2026 REAP Grant. Jeremy Bullard seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Petty-aye; Kimble-aye; Bullard-aye. The motion carried.

The Board discussed with Danny Hulsey about the Bull Hill Project over Unnamed Creek and Oak Creek Project, J/P#32347(04), Latimer County, within District #3. Hulsey stated his concern regarding his property and the current right of way acquisitions plan on the East side of the project. The Commissioners stated that they have to follow ODOT standards regarding the project, but would take the concerns into consideration.

The Board reviewed the Emergency Managements weekly report.

The Board discussed the tentative abatement for the Latimer County Courthouse and plan of action regarding the departments within the Courthouse.

At 11:00 a.m., the Board opened and discussed the 3-month bid on 8' railroad car/pipe.

Jeremy Bullard made a motion to award the 3-month bid on 8' railroad car/pipe to Railroad Yard. Rodger Kimble seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Petty-aye; Kimble-aye; Bullard-aye. The motion carried.
