

LATIMER COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

MEETING MINUTES FOR AUGUST 3, 2026

The Latimer County Commissioners met in a regular meeting on Monday, August 3, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. at the Latimer County Courthouse located at 109 N Central, Wilburton, OK. Members present were Jeremy Bullard, Jaden Petty and Rodger Kimble. Jaden Petty, Chairman, called the meeting to order.

Jeremy Bullard made a motion to approve the minutes from 07/27/2026. Rodger Kimble seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Bullard-aye; Petty-aye; Kimble-aye. The motion carried.

Jeremy Bullard made a motion to approve an ODOT 324a Form between Latimer County and Pinnacle Consulting Management Group, Inc., for payment on Parcels 1 and 2 and Acquisition Secured/Condemned 50% on Parcels 1 and 2 for a total of \$6,500.00 for the NS-439 over Trib. To Little Buffalo Bridge Project, J2-8615(04), for services ending 06/30/2026, Latimer County, within District #2. Rodger Kimble seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Bullard-aye; Petty-aye; Kimble-aye. The motion carried.

Rodger Kimble made a motion to approve the request from the Town of Red Oak of 1 load of UPM to be delivered to the cement pad at the park. Jeremy Bullard seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Bullard-aye; Petty-aye; Kimble-aye. The motion carried.

Rodger Kimble made a motion to approve the request from Buffalo Valley Schools, regarding the hauling of red clay mix from GKC Construction Services to the Buffalo Valley School Baseball Field. Jeremy Bullard seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Bullard-aye; Petty-aye; Kimble-aye. The motion carried.

The Board discussed with the Elected Officials present the budget worksheet for FY 2026-2027. No action was taken.

Under new business:

The Commissioners discussed with the representatives present regarding the bridge inspection companies that could service Latimer County.

At 11:00 a.m. the Board open, discussed and were not able to award the bid for the 25' flat bed trailer with a 5' dovetail as needed for the 2026 REAP grant/Latimer County Conservation District.
