MEETING MINUTES FOR AUGUST 10, 2026

No new business was discussed.



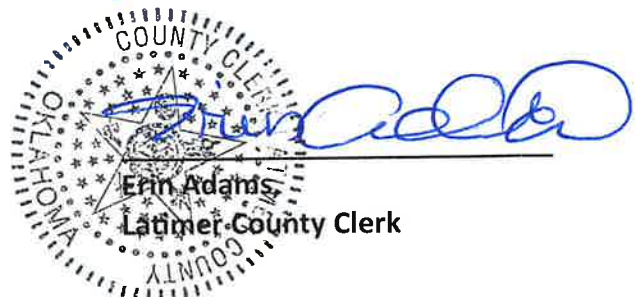
