MEETING MINUTES FOR AUGUST 24, 2026

The Latimer County Commissioners met in a regular meeting on Monday, August 24, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. at the Latimer County Courthouse located at 109 N Central, Wilburton, OK. Jaden Petty, Chairman, called the meeting to order.

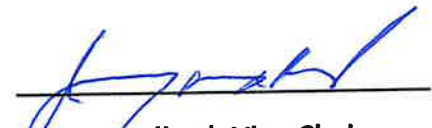
New or unforeseen business at the time of posting this agenda.
