MEETING MINUTES FOR SEPTEMBER 8, 2026

The Latimer County Commissioners met in a regular meeting on Tuesday, September 8, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. at the Latimer County Courthouse located at 109 N Central, Wilburton, OK. Jaden Petty, Chairman, called the meeting to order.

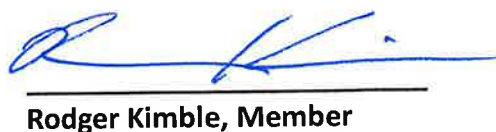
The Board discussed the budget for Latimer County for FY 2026-2027. No action was taken.

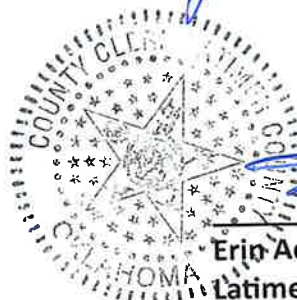
Under new business:
