The Latimer County Board of County Commissioners met on January 27, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioner's Office located in the Latimer County Courthouse, 109 N. Central, Wilburton, Oklahoma. Jeremy Bullard, Chairman called the meeting to order.



Under new business:


The Commissioners discussed the AT&T fiber project and the ground breaking ceremony location.
