LATIMER COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MINUTES FOR AUGUST 25, 2025

The Latimer County Commissioners met in a regular meeting on Monday, August 25, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. at the Latimer County Courthouse located at 109 N. Central, Wilburton, OK. Erin Adams, Latimer County Clerk took the minutes.

Jeremy Bullard, Chairman called the meeting to order.

Purdue Pharma LP., et al., Case No. 1:20-op-45003-DAP,* pending in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Ohio, and related litigation), including potential resolution of certain claims against Purdue Pharma LP and its affiliated entities and members of the Sackler family (the "Sacklers"), related to lawsuits against pharmaceutical supply chain participants of opioid prescription drugs, and taking appropriate action in open session, including possible authorization to settle claims, the disclosure of which may seriously impair the litigation if known by public disclosure as allowed by 25 O.S. § 307(B)(4). Rodger Kimble made a motion to accept the Thirteenth Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization of Purdue and Its Affiliated Debtors in Participation in Case No. 19-23649 pending in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York, and authorizing and directing its legal counsel vote to accept the Plan via master ballot or otherwise, and approving voting to accept and participate in the Governmental Entities Settlement Agreement (the "GESA") dated June 17, 2025, and the Purdue State-Subdivision Agreement as it pertains to the Plan and the GESA, including approval of **Resolution No. 2025-44**, and authorize the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners to execute the Subdivision Participation Form for the County of Latimer's participation in the GESA. Jaden Petty seconded the motion. The motion was voted as follows: Bullard-aye; Petty-aye; Kimble-aye. The motion carried.
