(State of Oklahoma 911 Management Authority Grant Application)

WHEREAS, the Latimer County E911 Department takes the Emergency 911 calls for the Citizens of Latimer County; and it is imperative to have proper mapping and addresses for the citizens of Latimer County, and the Latimer County Commissioners want to improve emergency dispatch and the 911 services for all residents of Latimer County; and

WHEREAS, the Latimer County Commissioners have determined that an updated GIS mapping system would enhance health and public safety for the citizens of Latimer County; and

WHEREAS, Latimer County needs additional funding to complete a GIS mapping update, and the Oklahoma 911 Management Authority has grant funding available for the GIS mapping; and

WHEREAS, Latimer County has agreed to apply for the grant funds through the Oklahoma 911 Management Authority for GIS mapping; and

WHEREAS, Latimer County agrees to provide local funding to meet the required twenty percent local match as required under state guidelines.
