

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-21

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF THE OPIOID ABATEMENT GRANT APPLICATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF FUNDED PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma, through the Office of the Attorney General and the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board, has made funds available to counties for opioid abatement through the Opioid Abatement Grant; and

WHEREAS, Latimer County seeks to apply for and utilize these funds to implement evidence-based and collaborative opioid abatement strategies that address prevention, treatment, and recovery services for individuals and communities impacted by opioid use disorder; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Latimer County, Oklahoma, recognizes the urgent need to reduce the harms of opioid misuse and is committed to supporting public health and safety through coordinated local initiatives;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Latimer County, Oklahoma:

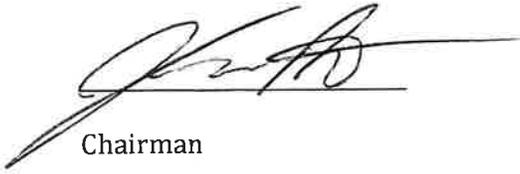
1. That the Board hereby authorizes submission of the Opioid Abatement Grant Application to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board.
2. That the Chairperson of the Board, or their designee, is authorized to execute all necessary documents and agreements related to the application and acceptance of any awarded grant funds.
3. That the County agrees to implement the proposed projects and activities as described in the grant application, including any subsequent revisions or additions required by the funding agency, consistent with all applicable state and federal laws, regulations, and reporting requirements.
4. That Latimer County will provide oversight of the implementation of funded projects and ensure proper fiscal management and accountability for grant expenditures.

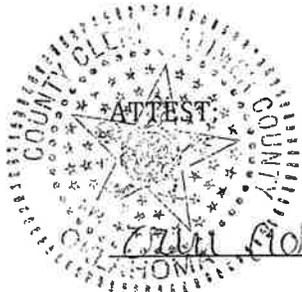
