


**THE LATIMER COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**, assure the Federal Insurance Administrator that they will enact and maintain in force rules for those areas identified as special flood hazard areas pursuant to 44 CFR Section 59 through 77, with effective enforcement provisions consistent with the criteria set forth in Section 60 of the National Flood Insurance Program Regulations; AND


**THE LATIMER COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS** designates **NATHAN MONTGOMERY** as the Floodplain Administrator to maintain for public inspection and to furnish upon request, for the determination of applicable flood insurance risk premiums within all areas having special flood hazards identified on the Latimer County Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM), and Certificates of Elevation of flood proofing and information on the lowest floor elevation of all new or substantially improved structures, and include whether or not such structures contain a basement and if the structure has been flood proofed and that the Floodplain Administrator will generally do all such things as in his judgment that may be necessary, proper, or expedient in the accomplishment of his duties; AND

**THE LATIMER COUNTY FLOODPLAIN ADMINISTRATOR** shall perform the duties and responsibilities delineated in the Latimer County Floodplain Board, Floodplain Management Regulations or Ordinance, as the case may be, as delineated in Article IV, Administration Section B.
