

The Latimer County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on 11/17/2025 at 9:00 a.m. During the course of that meeting the following resolution was offered:

WHEREAS: The ad valorem revenues are not adequate to meet the cost of operating county government, and whereas, a 1/4 cent sales tax that was proposed and passed by a majority of voters on February 8, 2022, for the sole benefit of General Government, Latimer County Solid Waste and Latimer County 911 will expire December 31, 2026, and whereas, a perpetual 1/4 cent sales tax is required to meet the costs of operating County Government, Latimer County Solid Waste and Latimer County 911.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF LATIMER, OKLAHOMA THAT AN ELECTION IS HEREBY CALLED FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING THE FOLLOWING PROPOSITION TO A VOTE OF THE PEOPLE OF LATIMER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA ON THE 10TH DAY OF FEBRUARY 2026:

PROPOSITION No. 1

Shall a 1/4 cent sales tax in Latimer County by the Latimer County Government continue perpetually for the establishment, maintenance and operation of County Government, Latimer County Solid Waste and Latimer County 911 be approved by the people and divided as follows:

1/8 to Latimer County General Fund 1/16 to Latimer County Solid Waste Trust Authority 1/16 to Latimer County 911

The ballots used at said election shall set out the proposition as above set forth, and shall also contain the following words:

Yes, for the above proposition

No, for the above proposition
